Youth Hub of Chokwe

On June 6, 2023, the CDD Youth Hub in Chókhwè visited the town of Nwachicoluane to promote a lecture at the local secondary school to make students aware of the importance of caring for the environment.

During the lecture, several ways to preserve the environment were highlighted, such as the rational use of water, the practice of different types of recycling and the correct separation of waste. The lecture covered about 45 students.

Youth Hub of Massingir

On June 9, 2023, CDD Youth Hub in Massingir held a cleaning day and a lecture on attitudes and daily habits for the preservation of the environment. The clean-up journey aimed to engage young people and raise awareness in the community about the importance of caring for

the environment through water conservation, recycling waste efficiently and ecologically, advocacy for reducing environmental pollution and planting trees. The activity involved several young people and members of the local community.



Youth Hub of Chimbunila

In turn, the youth of CDD Youth Hub in Chimbunila held, on the morning of June 10th, a debate on the importance of environmental conservation. The activity was attended by other young members of civil society.

Chimbunila district faces challenges related to

uncontrolled fires and the indiscriminate felling of trees for the production of charcoal. Therefore, the debate discussed forms of conservation and maintenance of the environment, as well as the recovery of the ecosystem and the prevention of ecological imbalance.



Youth Hub of Moma

On the 10th of June, the youth of CDD *Youth Hub* in Moma participated in a cleaning campaign at the Central Market in Moma. The campaign aimed to raise awareness about the rational use of resources and the ecological management of solid waste, in addition to transmitting citizenship values to new generations. The activity contributed to the restoration, preservation and sanitation of the local environment.



Youth Hub of Chimbunila

On the 16th of June, the youth of the *Youth Hub* of Chimbunila proceeded to plant trees (acacias) at Undi Primary School. In addition to the youth of the *Youth Hub* of Chimbunila, students and school management, the activity was attended by a representative of the District Education, Youth and Technology Services (SDEJT). The purpose of planting the trees was to highlight their importance in the production of oxygen, air humidity, erosion prevention, temperature balance and providing shelter for various species of animals.
