Bloody Night in Ribáuè, Nampula

•Last night, Ribáuè, in the province of Nampula, experienced moments of extreme violence that marked not only the night but the entire day as bloody.



he first incident occurred during the day, when a direct confrontation between the police and the Naparamas resulted, according to local sources, in the deaths of five members of the Naparama group. The image below depicts the fatalities from this clash.

The night, however, was marked by an authentic massacre, described as a "rusga" or indiscriminate killing, which claimed the lives of 10 civilians. The victims' bodies were found scattered across various streets in the region, as shown in the photo below. In addition, there are reports of dozens of people missing from local communities, increasing the atmosphere of fear and uncertainty.

This incident is considered the worst since the beginning of the violent protests. The situation in Nampula province remains extremely tense, with ongoing confrontations between the Naparamas and the police.

There are also reports of violent operations carried out by the police in local communities, forcing many residents to seek refuge in other parts of the province. The scenario is bleak and highlights the severity of the escalating crisis in the region.
